

Purpose

Within the Greater Rockford Area 6.90% of families and 9.60% of the population live below the poverty line. Including 12.90% of those under age 18 The Northern Illinois Food Bank is committed to combat childhood hunger. In Winnebago and Boone Counties, the Northern Illinois Food Bank operates the Youth Nutrition Program (YNP).

Eight years ago the Northern Illinois Food Bank launched its first Youth Nutrition Program by providing lunches during the summer to low-income children. Since that time, Northern Illinois Food Bank has worked with the Illinois State Board of Education to become a sponsor for the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) and the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP). Through SFSP and CACFP contracts as well as charitable gifts, the YNP has increased the amount of food provided to children who lack access to adequate amounts of nutritious food.

Challenged by a growing number of children living in poverty and those eligible for free-reduced priced lunches, as well as a diverse geographic area, Northern Illinois Food Bank executes a year-round, multi-faceted approach to addressing childhood hunger.

The proceeds of this tournament directly support the Youth Nutrition Program in Winnebago and Boone Counties.

Team Configuration and Games

Teams shall be Male & Female (Coed Teams Play in Male Division) Min. 6 Teams per Division, First Come First Registered.

Games are played as 20 min game, consisting of two ten min. halves, with 1 min halftime and free substitution.

Teams are Guaranteed Three Games minimum.

First two games, randomly selected by tournament committee, results of these games determine standings for the play offs. Ties in standings shall be resolved by coin flip at the discretion of the tournament committee.

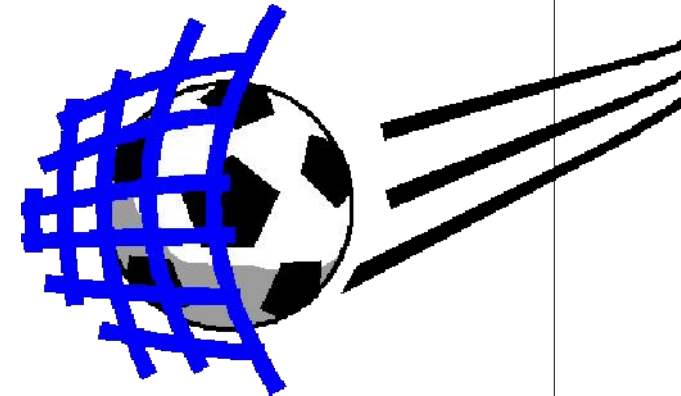
Awards shall be given to the top team in each division.
